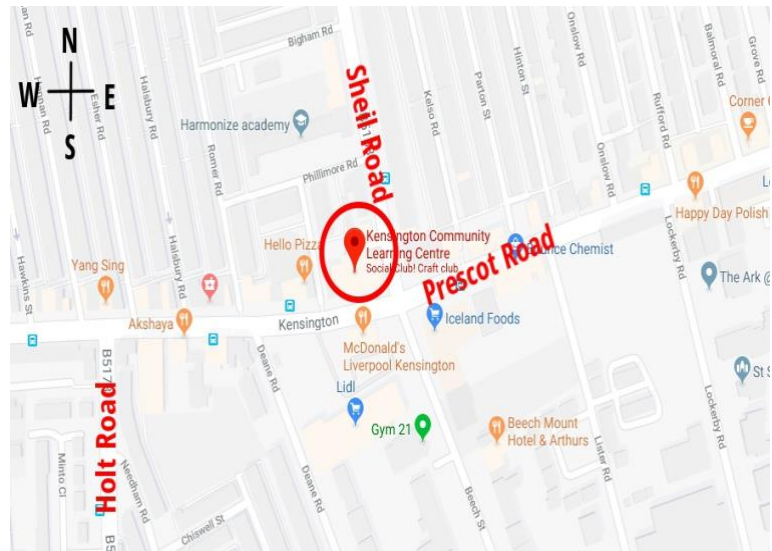
Thursday 7th March, 6-8pm: International Women's Day Craft Club
